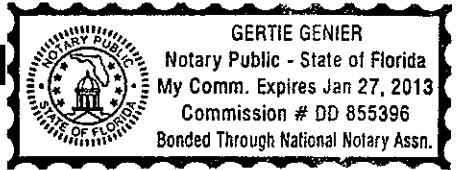

SHELTON POST-NUPTIAL AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made by and between BRANDY SHELTON, (hereinafter referred to as the "Wife") residing in West Frankfort, Illinois, and DANNY LEE SHELTON, (hereinafter referred to as the "Husband"), residing in West Frankfort, Illinois.

THAT WHEREAS, the parties hereto were lawfully joined in marriage on _____, 2007, at _____, _____ County, _____; and,

WHEREAS, no children were born to the parties as a result of the marriage or adopted by the parties; and the Wife is not now pregnant; and

WHEREAS, should at any time in the future irreconcilable and unfortunate differences arise between the parties which should render impossible a continuation of the marital relationship existing between them, the parties wish to set out their agreement as is hereinafter set forth; and,

WHEREAS, both parties expressly state that they have each freely and voluntarily entered into this Agreement of their own volition, free of any duress or coercion and with full knowledge of each and every provision contained in this Agreement and the consequences thereof. Each party expressly states that no representation has been made to him or to her by the other party or by the other's attorney other than what is contained in this Agreement; that the parties, after carefully considering the terms of this Agreement, state that they do not regard it to be unconscionable; and,

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WHEREAS, Husband has engaged Timothy R. Neubauer of Timothy R. Neubauer & Associates, P.C. as his attorney, and Wife has declined to obtain an attorney, and the attorney for Husband has drafted this instrument, and this instrument purports to be, and in fact is, a written expression of the oral agreement heretofore entered into between the parties; and,

WHEREAS, the attorney for Husband by this statement has informed Wife that he represents Husband only; that he cannot in any way represent Wife nor render her legal advice since there would be a conflict of interest; that Wife has the right to obtain an attorney to represent her; and,

WHEREAS, without any collusion as to any future dissolution proceedings, or any other proceedings that may be filed between the parties affecting the marital status of the parties, and in the interest of avoiding protracted litigation, the parties consider it to be to their respective best interests to settle, adjust and compromise between themselves now and forever, the matters of maintenance (formerly referred to as alimony), payment of attorney's fees, the settlement of the property rights of the parties with respect to both marital and non-marital property, and the disposition of all claims, whether arising by virtue of the marriage of the parties hereto or otherwise, which each party hereto ever had, now has or may have in the future against the other, whether arising under the laws of Illinois or any other State or Country, for or on account of any matter whatever; and all rights, whether arising by virtue of the marriage of the parties hereto or otherwise, which each party hereto ever had, now has or may have in the future, or may claim to have whether arising under the laws of Illinois or any other State or Country, in or to any and all property, real, personal or

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mixed, tangible and intangible, marital and non-marital, heretofore or hereafter owned or possessed by the other party hereto, including without limitation of the foregoing, all inchoate rights and all rights of homestead, inheritance, descent, distribution, community interest and surviving spouse's award; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and in consideration of the mutual covenants of the parties hereto, hereinafter set forth and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which are jointly and severally acknowledged, it is hereby freely and voluntarily covenanted and agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are made part of this Agreement.
2. Right to Prosecute or Defend. This Agreement is not made to induce either of the parties hereto to obtain or stimulate a judgment for dissolution of marriage. Both parties reserve the right to prosecute and defend any actions which may hereinafter be brought by either or both of them regarding the marriage.
3. Debts Assigned to Husband. In the event of a dissolution of marriage between the parties, the Husband shall be principally and primarily responsible and liable for all of the debts which are listed in Schedule "A", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, and Husband shall hold Wife harmless from such debts and liabilities.
4. Debts Assigned to Wife. In the event of a dissolution of marriage between the parties, the Wife shall be principally and primarily responsible and liable for all of the debts which are listed in Schedule "B", which is attached hereto and made

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a part hereof, and the Wife shall hold Husband harmless from such debts and liabilities.

5. Personal Property Awarded to Wife. In the event of a dissolution of marriage between the parties, Wife shall be awarded all personal property listed in Schedule "C", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof and shall receive all scheduled properties listed therein within one week of the date of the entry of a Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage.

6. Personal Property Awarded to Husband. In the event of a dissolution of marriage between the parties, Husband shall be awarded all personal property listed in Schedule "D", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof and shall receive all scheduled properties listed therein within one week of the entry of a Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage.

7. Insurance Policy. In the event of a dissolution of marriage between the parties, each party shall be awarded all life insurance policies insuring their own life, except that Wife shall be named as the beneficiary on the \$25,000.00 policy issued on Husband's life through 3ABN until such time as Husband satisfies the payment of maintenance to the Wife as set forth in Paragraph 11 of this Agreement.

8. Payment for Cosmetology School. In the event of a dissolution of marriage between the parties, Husband shall pay for Wife to attend cosmetology school for one (1) year, or a maximum of \$5,800.00, within five years from the date a Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage is entered approving this Agreement.

9. Marital Residence. The parties acknowledge that the Husband had a home which he was awarded pursuant to his agreement with his former wife, Linda

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Sue Shelton. That home has been sold and the proceeds from that sale have been used to purchase new real estate in West Frankfort, Illinois, on which he is currently building a home which will be subject to a mortgage. This new home and the real estate described in Schedule "E", which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, shall be considered Husband's sole property, without any claim from the marital estate of the parties hereto for any subsequent additions to the home or for payments of the mortgage. Specifically, the martial estate shall have no claim of any contribution from the Husband, nor shall the Wife and/or the marital estate have any claim against the Husband for reimbursement for any monies or personal efforts from the Husband.

10. Attorney's Fees. Each party shall pay his or her own attorney fees not specifically ordered to be paid by the other party and agrees that this Court shall retain jurisdiction of this matter for the purpose of determining the amount of attorney fees owed by each party to his or her own attorney. Husband shall be responsible for payment of Court costs (filing fees, service of Summons fees, etc. if applicable).

11. Payment of Maintenance (Formerly Referred to as Alimony). In the event either party hereto files a Petition for Dissolution of the marriage or should the parties separate (no longer reside in the same residence), Husband agrees to commence paying to Wife the amount of \$1,317.00 per month for a consecutive period of twelve (12) months from the date of filing a Petition for Dissolution of Marriage or the date of separation, whichever first occurs, and thereafter the amount of \$660.00 per month for the next eighteen (18) months.

Said maintenance shall automatically terminate upon the death of the Wife or upon the remarriage of the Wife.

The parties agree that said spousal support shall not be modifiable at any time hereafter (including the two (2) years and six (6) months period), so that at the conclusion of the two (2) year and six (6) month payment each party shall thereafter be forever barred from claiming any future maintenance from the other as it is the intent of the parties that maintenance shall only be paid for a maximum of two (2) years and six (6) months, unless terminated earlier for any reason enumerated above.

12. Release. In the event of a dissolution of the marriage of the parties, to the fullest extent by law permitted to do so, and except as herein otherwise provided, each of the parties does hereby forever relinquish, release, waive and forever quitclaim and grant to the other, his or her heirs, personal representatives and assigns the following:

(a) All rights of inheritance, descent and distribution, and community interest;

(b) All other rights, title, claim, interest and estate as husband and wife, widow or widower, or otherwise, by reason of the marital relations existing between said parties hereto, under any present or future law, or which he or she otherwise has or might have or be entitled to claim in, to or against the property and assets of the other, real, personal or mixed, whether marital or non-marital, or his or her estate, whether now owned or hereafter in any manner acquired by the other party, or whether in possession or in expectancy and whether vested or contingent;

(c) Each party further covenants and agrees for himself or herself, his or her heirs, personal representatives and assigns, that neither of them will at any time hereafter sue the other or his or her heirs, personal representatives, grantees,

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devises or assigns, for the purpose of enforcing any or either of the rights specified or relinquished in this Agreement, except that either party may seek any judicial remedy available to him or her for the enforcement of the terms of this Agreement. Each party further agrees that in the event any suit shall be commenced (including, but not limited to, any claim by either party for emotional distress, personal injury, tort claim of any kind or nature, battery, or spousal abuse of any form or nature), this release, when pleaded, shall be and constitute a complete defense to any such claim or suit so instituted by either party hereto;

(d) Each party agrees to execute, acknowledge and deliver at the request of the other party, or his or her heirs, personal representatives, grantees, devisees or assigns, any or all such deeds, releases, or other instruments and further assurances as may be required or reasonably requested to effect or evidence such release, waiver, relinquishment or extinguishment of such rights, provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall operate or be construed as a waiver or release by either party to the other of the obligation on the part of the other to comply with the provisions of this Agreement; and

(e) Except as expressly provided by this Agreement, each party hereby releases and/or waives any interest, beneficial or otherwise, which he or she may have acquired in or to ANY AND ALL assets evidenced by an instrument naming the non-owning party a beneficiary, a successor in interest, or giving any rights of survivorship, and such interests are hereby specifically revoked by the owning party as if revoked on the face of the instrument. This waiver, release and revocation shall include, but not be limited to, life insurance policy(ies), (except the \$25,000.00 life insurance policy

through 3ABN on which Wife is the named beneficiary), Certificates of Deposit, bonds, annuities, bills, notes or other Savings Plans of every kind, including Employee Savings Plans, owned by the other, unless any such interest is specifically set forth herein. The intent of this subparagraph is that ALL interests, as set forth above, are released whether or not the party owning the life insurance policy(ies), Certificates of Deposit, bonds, annuities, bills, notes or other Savings Plans, including Employee Savings Plans, takes any action to remove the other's name from any document indicating they have any type of ownership or any other interest. Further, if a non-owning party receives any asset or money due to the owning party's failure to revoke any non-owning party's interest, the non-owning party shall immediately pay over such asset or money to the owning party or owning party's estate.

13. Preclusion to Modification. As is provided by 750 ILCS 5-502(f), each of the parties shall be precluded from seeking any modification of this Post-Nuptial Agreement, including, but not limited to, obligations and debts of the parties, payment of spousal support or maintenance (formerly referred to as alimony), to the division of property of the other, whether real, personal or mixed, of whatever kind and nature and wheresoever situated, including, but not limited to, homestead, succession and inheritance, arising out of the marital relationship or any other relationship existing between the parties hereto.

14. Incorporation of Terms into Judgment. In the event either the Husband and Wife, at any time, hereafter, obtains a Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage, this Agreement and all of its provisions and terms shall be submitted to the Court for its approval in connection with the dissolution of marriage of the parties, and

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all its provisions shall be set forth and incorporated in any Judgment for Dissolution of Marriage granted to the parties. Further, said Judgment shall provide that the terms of this Agreement shall be precluded from any modification as is provided by 750 ILCS 5/502(f). In the event that no Judgment for Dissolution is awarded to either of the parties in the above entitled cause of action, this Agreement shall be null, void and of no further force or effect.

15. Execution of Necessary Documents. The parties shall promptly, upon demand by the other, and any time hereafter, execute and deliver any and all documents and instruments as may be reasonably necessary to effectuate and fulfill the terms of this Agreement. The parties further elect to have the provisions of Section 1041 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, apply to all qualifying transfers of property between the parties hereto and shall execute the necessary Section 1041 election.

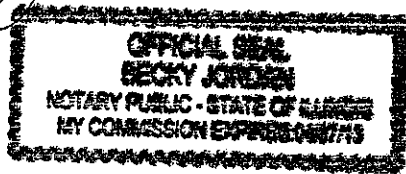
16. Binding Effect. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, their heirs, personal representatives and assigns.

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**ADDENDUM TO
SHELTON POST-NUPTIAL AGREEMENT**

DANNY LEE SHELTON and BRANDY SHELTON, in consideration of the covenants, promises and agreements contained herein, the sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby agree that the Shelton Post-Nuptial Agreement shall be amended as follows and this document will be attached to and become part of the Shelton Post-Nuptial Agreement between DANNY LEE SHELTON and BRANDY SHELTON, dated April 29, 2008.

1. Paragraph 8 – **Payment for Cosmetology School** shall be deleted in its entirety.

2. Paragraph 11 – **Payment of Maintenance (Formerly referred to as Alimony)** shall be deleted in its entirety and the following shall be inserted in its place: In the event either party hereto files a Petition for Dissolution of the marriage or should the parties separate (no longer reside in the same residence), Husband agrees to commence paying to Wife the amount of \$2,000.00 per month for a consecutive period of thirteen (13) months from the date of filing a Petition for Dissolution of Marriage or the date of separation, whichever first occurs, and thereafter the amount of \$660.00 per month for the next three (3) months.

Said maintenance shall automatically terminate upon the death of the Wife or upon the remarriage of the Wife.

The parties agree that said spousal support shall not be modifiable at any time hereafter (including the one (1) year and four (4) months period), so that at the conclusion of the one (1) year and four (4) month

payment each party shall thereafter be forever barred from claiming any future maintenance from the other as it is the intent of the parties that maintenance shall only be paid for a maximum of one (1) year and four (4) months, unless terminated earlier for any reason enumerated above.

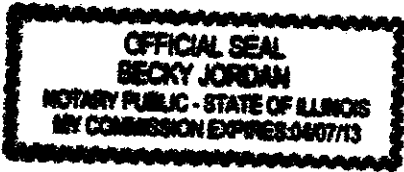
